UPCOMING TRIPS



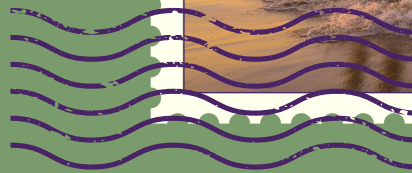
ALABAMA'S GULF SHORES APRIL 27-MAY 1, 2025
