

# Medora: North Dakota's Hidden Gem August 25-27, 2025

**Day 1:** Embark on a scenic road trip through North Dakota, beginning in Jamestown, affectionately known as Buffalo City. Here, the North American Bison Discovery Center offers insights into the majestic creatures that once roamed the plains, complemented by a visit to Dakota Thunder, the towering 26-foot-tall world's largest buffalo sculpture. We are staying in Dickinson, North Dakota at the Hampton Inn.

Day 2: Continuing westward, the journey leads to Assumption Abbey in Richardton, a serene Benedictine monastery established in 1893. Travel along the Enchanted Highway which captivates with its series of colossal scrap metal sculptures, including the Guinness-recognized "Geese in Flight." A delightful lunch awaits at the Enchanted Castle, a whimsical hotel and restaurant in Regent. The adventure culminates in Medora, where visitors can savor the unique Pitchfork Steak Fondue, enjoy a behind-the-scenes tour of North Dakota's most storied amphitheater, and experience the unique *Medora Musical*.

**Day 3:** On the return journey, a stop in Bismarck offers a historical look at the former North Dakota Governors Mansion, the residence of 20 governors from 1893 to 1960.
